ICCCS History

- Founded in Switzerland, 1972
- 1990 supported ISO/TC 209 to harmonise standards
- 2006 initiative to harmonise and accredit training courses
- 2015 formed executive board and technical committees to implement policies and initiatives agreed by the Council of Delegates
- Celebrated 50 years at ISCC22 symposium in Antalya, October 2022

- Launched 50YP programme to drive the next 50 years
- Coincide with 50 Year anniversary – past 50 years
- Next generation of volunteers in national member societies
- Future SMEs to write cleanroom and contamination control standards
- In return the ICCCS will organise mentoring and CPD, including technical training and education

- Coordinated by Orkun Ozkurt, CTS Turkey (idea and launched at ISCC22)
- Team leaders in 50YPs to be encouraged in groups
- Organic growth expected over next 3-5 years
- Develop 50YP programme in consultation with 50YPs

Why are we searching 50YP

National member societies need Volunteers on their committees and SMEs to promote best practice in cleanroom and contamination control technologies and be nominated to represent their national standards body in the ISO process and working groups.

As part of 50 YP programme the ICCCS will organise and sponsor YPs to join ICCCS, regional and national member society events. This includes attendance at ICCCS Accredited Course and dedicated YP training sessions in both technical personal development areas, as part of wider CPD programmes in their own companies or organisations.

How long is the 50YP Programme?

The programme commenced at and was designed to coincide with the 50 Year Anniversary celebrations at the ISCC22 symposium in Antalya, Turkey in October 2022, with 16 new Young Professionals.

This is why we chose the name 50YP. We plan this as a rolling programme with YPs being mentored and supported over a 2 year period, maybe longer depending on circumstances. We hope to have a continuous roll of up to 50 Young Professionals

The 50YP programme will be a key part of the ongoing ICCCS strategy to be relevant to national member societies and provide the future volunteers to support the sustainable growth of national member societies, and new SMEs in driving international standardisation and best practice in cleanroom and contamination control technologies.



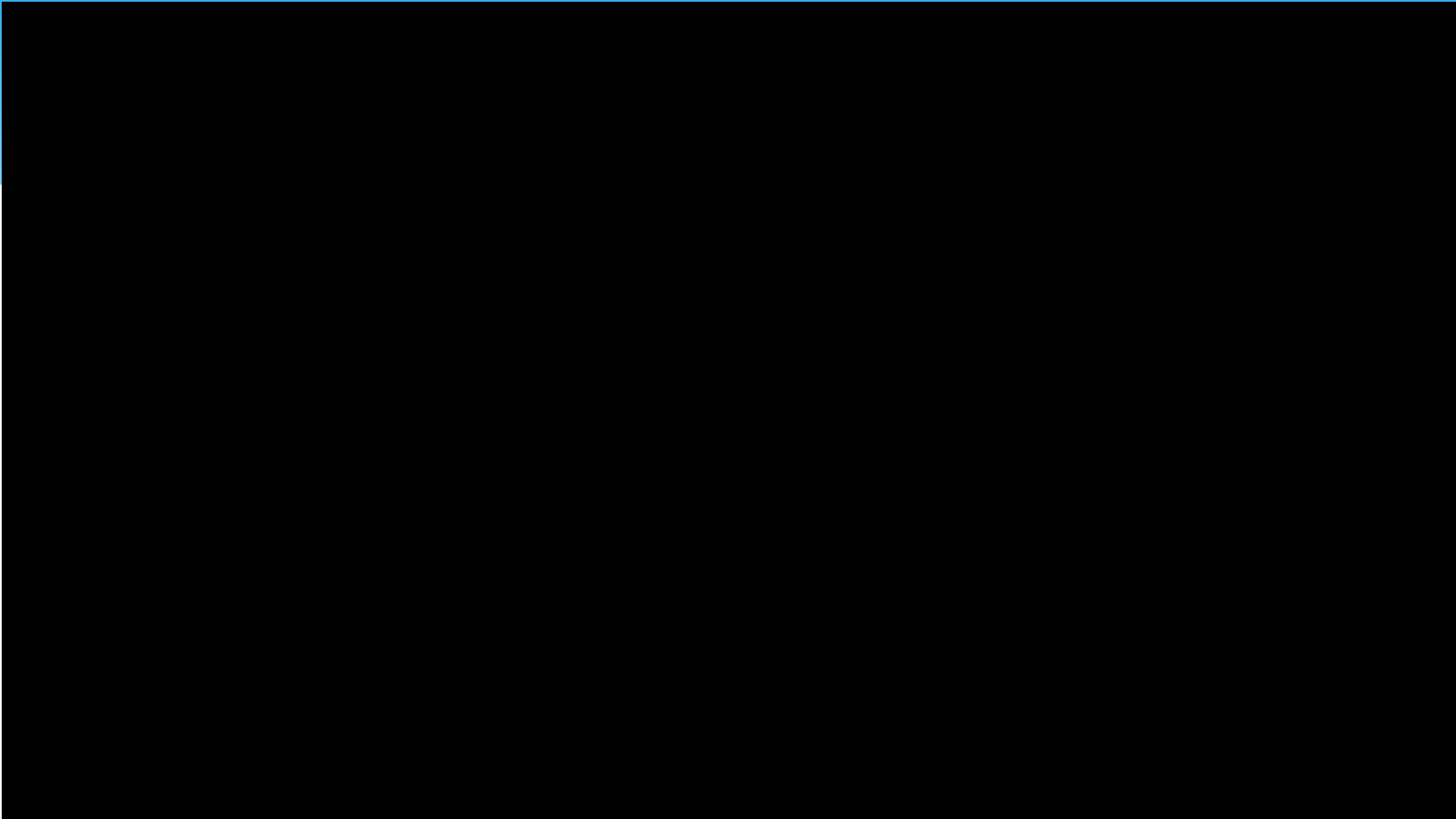
ISCC'22 Antalya

ISCC22 was held in Antalya by the Cleanroom Technologies Society of Turkiye on 11-13 October 2022, This also coincided with celebrating the 50 year anniversary of the foundation of the ICCCS in 1972.
